Description of Event Material:

Students that are not ranked in Matayoshi Kobudo should not expect to do all Kobudo material including kata, bunkai, kumite, or hojo undo. The event will cover all under black belt weapons in Matayoshi Kobudo and select advanced weapons for black belt students. Below are examples of what material may be covered for different levels. Not all material will necessarily be covered as adjustments will be made based on participants' experience levels.
